THE ONE CHAPTER TRIAL

1. Plan

Review the Hi PATH chapter, focusing on the prompts at the bottom. Prepare student name chits in advance and place them in a box for pairing.

2. RANDOM PAIRING

Divide the class into pairs randomly. Invite one child to come forward and pick two names at a time. Those two become partners for the day

3. TEACHER-CHILD DEMONSTRATION

- A. Close your eyes and pick a random name chit that child is your demo partner.
- B. Check the prompts at the bottom of the page; they tell you the task.
- C. You go first:
 ask/solve/read and show
 how to say "Well done!"
 or "Try again." Give a high
 five.
- D. Then the child does the same with another question/line and also says "Well done!" and gives a high five.
- E. Demo is complete only when both have taken a turn this shows the class how to learn with a partner.

4. ENTIRE CLASS WORKS IN PAIRS

Now, the whole class works in pairs.
Remind them to take turns as
equals and not repeat what their
partner has already said or read.
Each child should contribute
something new during their turn.

5. FEEDBACK

Take a test of your children to see how much they learned this way. Monitor the same test in other sections.



Do children stay with the same partner?

They sit with a new partner each day. This variety helps them learn to adjust, communicate, and think in new ways — making learning deeper and more meaningful.

Do we group children by ability?

We never label children as strong or weak. Random pairing naturally balances abilities. When a child works with someone who learns differently — including those with special needs — both grow in understanding, empathy, and confidence. It builds the 4Cs: collaboration, communication, creativity, and critical thinking.

Will it take longer to teach a chapter this way?




